

SANITARY PROTOCOL - COVID-19 PROCEDURE

ASD Montignoso Ciclismo Organizing Body of the Trofeo Oro in Euro – Women’s Bike Race - which will take place on 02.03.2022 in compliance with the Decree-Law of the Italian Government n ° 229 of 30.12.2021 Art. 1 Comma (a) and (b), of the “New” Anti-Covid-19 Protocol issued by the UCI on 21.01.2022 implements the following health protocol for all members of the Teams, UCI Commission, Organizational Management and service personnel.

The general principle of this health protocol is compliance with both the Anticovid-19 Protocol of the UCI and the Decree-law issued by the Italian government with this theory, the group of people (motorcyclists, staff members, technical personnel, etc.) entering in the “Bubbles” (protected environment) during their stay, they must respect a behaviour that avoids prolonged contact with people outside their group.

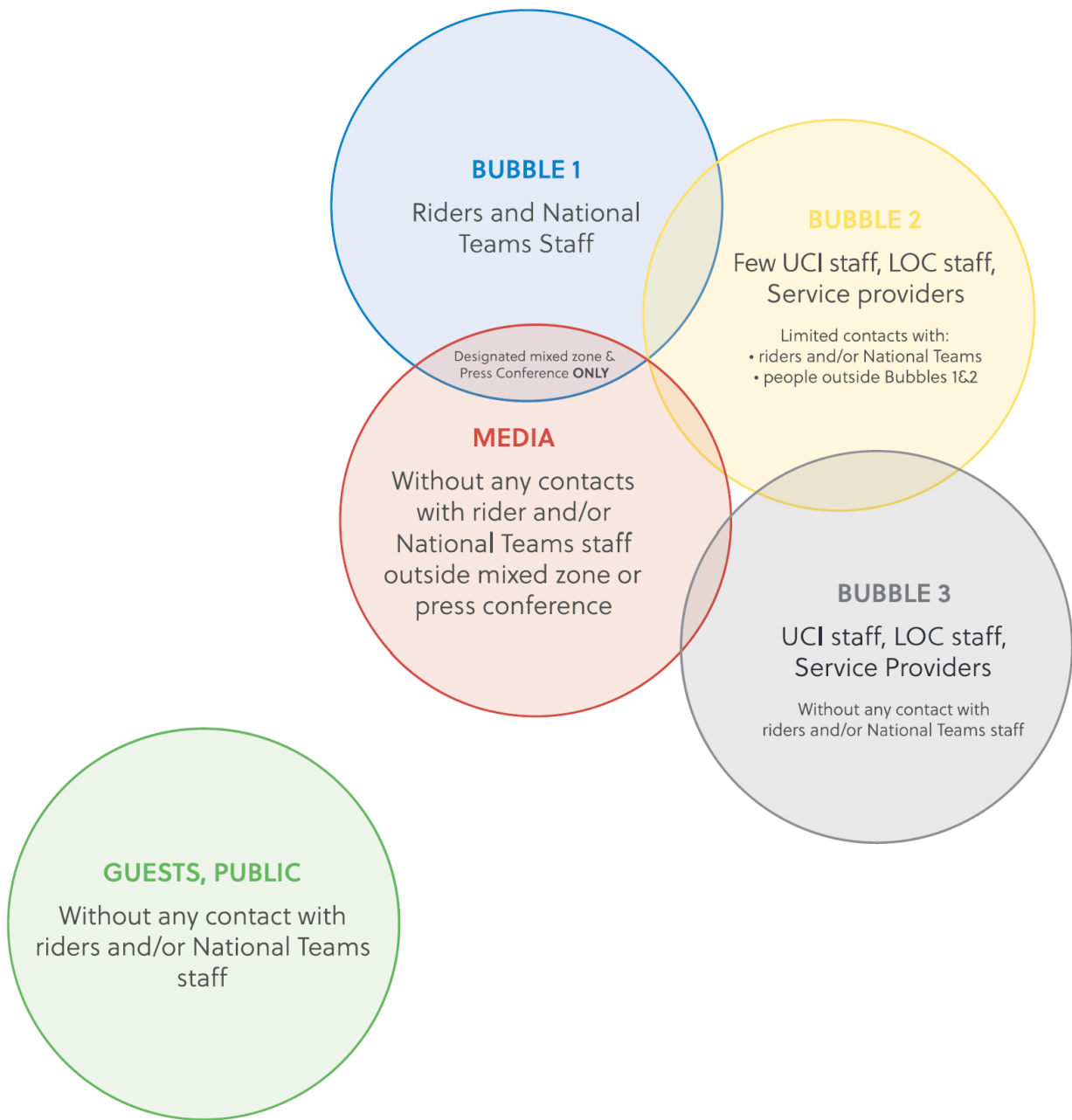
Everyone present at the event site will be assigned in bubbles with varying levels of protection (see Figure). The teams, riders and support staff will be integrated into a bubble with a maximum level of protection and a minimum level of interaction with the environment.

- *About the Covid-19 emergency, the Organizer undertakes to put in place a series of measures and precautions aimed at preventing the spread of the virus and not creating assemblies.*
- *During the License Verification operations, which will take place on the day before the race, the provisions of current national and regional regulations will obviously be respected, paying particular attention to compliance with the use of masks, the presence of sanitizing gel, physical spacing among all the people present: Jury, Sports Directors, organization staff, journalists, and photographers. Furthermore, the time taken for checking the starters and for the technical meeting will be limited to the minimum necessary.*
- *As regards the day of the race, and during the start, finish, and award ceremony, all the mandatory precautions will be implemented, complying with the provisions of the protocols drawn up by the UCI and the Italian Cycling Federation and the specific rules issued by Institutions.*

ACCOMMODATION IN THE HOTEL

- In compliance with the Decree-Law of the Italian Government n ° 229 of 30.12.2021, access to the accommodation facilities reserved for the Teams and to all staff following the Event is allowed only to people who have completed the Complete vaccination cycle and be in possession of the "**GREEN PASS REINFORCED**"

BUBBLES



GENERAL MEASURES

General measures will be applied to all people on the site, regardless of their bubble, namely: Face masks (FPP2) must be worn at all times at the event venue, except for riders during training, warming up and racing. **Any person at the event venue who is seen to be without a mask for an extended period will have their accreditation removed.**

Social distancing of minimum 1.5m is expected at all times. Keep in mind that face masks on their own cannot provide complete protection against infection, and there is a need to use them alongside maintaining physical distance.

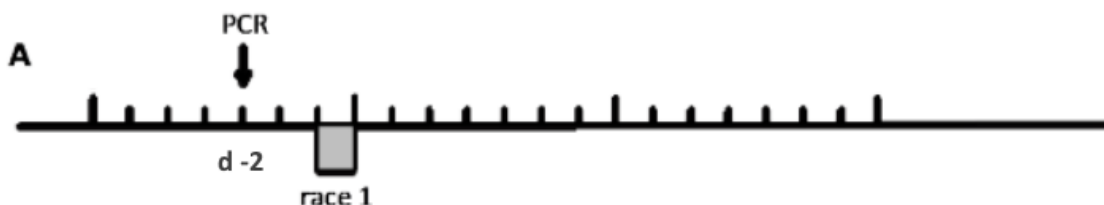
Regular hand washing/sanitizing is expected. Hand sanitizer will be provided at multiple locations on the event area.

Specific measures

will be applied to the teams (riders and staff members) and to people involved in the organisation.

For Athletes and Teams members following the Race, in order to participate in all phases of the Race, it will be MANDATORY to have completed the Vaccination cycle as per UCI regulations "OR" to be negative in the MOLECULAR diagnostic test (using the PCR-Test Technique), to D-2 (within 48 hours before the Event), ie before joining the "Team Bubble".

PCR tests performed as part of the mandatory entry procedures in countries (which have adopted this provision) can be used as pre-Competition tests. The goal is to optimize the test program by avoiding unnecessary repetitions.



APPLICATION OF THE COVID TESTS

The nature of the tests must comply with the UCI specifications as defined in the document available on the UCI website: [Link](#)

RESULT COMPILATION

The results must then be compiled in an Excel file available on the UCI website by clicking on « PCR test results ». The complete Excel sheet must be uploaded onto the dedicated platform to be checked by the UCI Medical Director.

The results and documents delivered by the laboratories must be kept individually so that they can be presented if necessary. Please note that only the Excel file must be sent, no other document must be uploaded.

LICENSE VERIFICATION PROCEDURE AND TECHNICAL MEETING

LICENSES CHECK

Access to the Team Meeting is allowed to only one Sports Director and respecting the time established previously by the Organizers in order not to create Assemblies.

Before entering in the room where the licenses check is done, the healthcare personnel will detect the body temperature.

Chronology of the Licenses Check

1. Acceptance of the Sports Director
2. Accreditation Form
3. Licenses Check
4. Team Meeting

08.45 – Opening of the secretariat.

09.45 - Opening of license verification operations only for Teams.

- Before entering the rooms of the Licensing Verification, the Healthcare staff will detect body temperature.
 1. **First step at the entrance:**
 - i. The team will have access to the competition only if the Sports Director provides the following documents to the first table:
 - Accreditation Form for Vehicles and Pass Cards
 - Confirmation Start 72hr
 - Organization staff will deliver an envelope containing the total number of pass cards (Yellow color required at the time of Confirmation of Starters (to access the Yellow Area reserved for Teams) in addition to the Vehicle Plates with respective marks following the race
 2. **Second Step** UCI staff, to verify Licenses and collect race numbers
 3. **Fourth Step** Reserved for Guest and Organization Accreditation
 4. **Fifth Step** Reserved for press accreditations

Once all the aforementioned procedures have been completed, the Sports Director of the Team leaves the License Verification office and awaits the moment of the Technical Meeting.

11.15 – only one Sports Directors, keeping the devices and the safety distances, participate in the Technical Meeting.

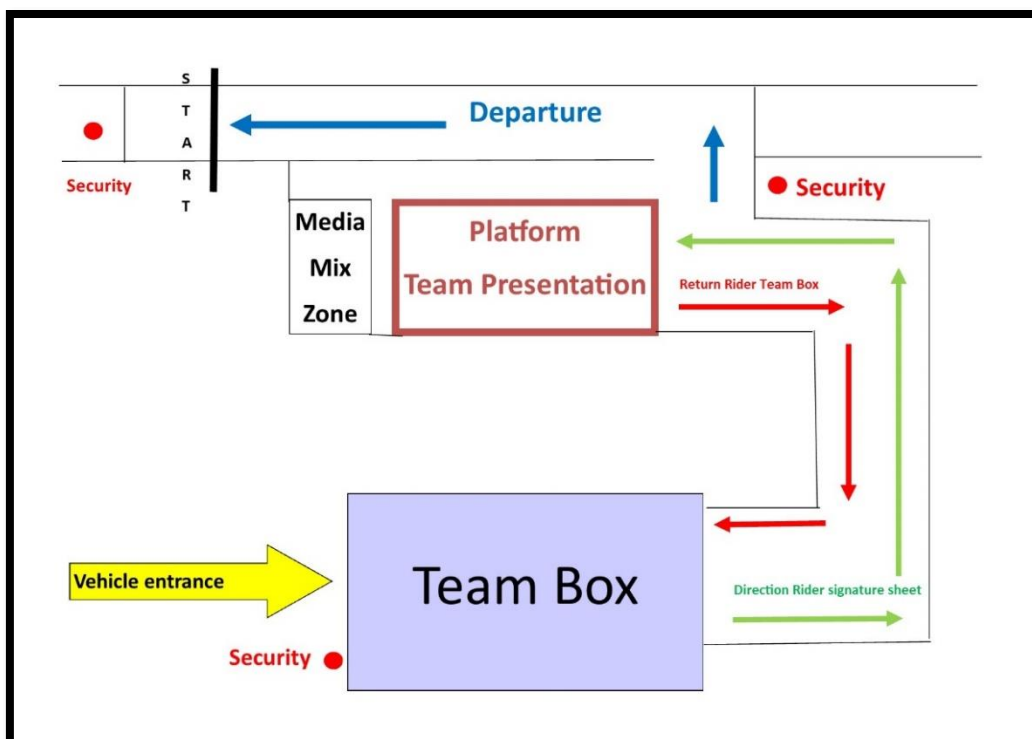
YELLOW ZONE

As regards the Yellow Zone (which will be delimited with signs bearing the words "Yellow Zone"), only all those in possession of a Yellow Pass are admitted and the following provisions are implemented:

RACE START

- In the Accreditation Form each team must declare (under his responsibility) how many pass cards he needs and who is going to use these pass cards (that can't be given to someone else, or it will be reported to competent bodies)
- The parking zone for buses and cars ("Box Team" will be closed to the public: only the team members (with the yellow pass card), first grade Organizers and UCI Commissioners are allowed to enter in this zone. No one else can. All the accesses will be supervised by Organization Staff.
- From Box Team to Signature Podium there will be a delimited aisle where only Riders can enter.
- Riders must go to Signature Podium wearing a mask and they must respect the Schedule established by organizers.
- Next to the Podium there will be a "Media Mix Zone" where, respecting the distance, the Riders can do some interviews. Only Riders, First Grade Organizers, Media and one Press Officer with the Yellow Pass are allowed to enter in the Media Mix Zone
- Coming back to the Box Team, Riders will follow the same aisle (separated from the Riders that are going to the Signature Podium).

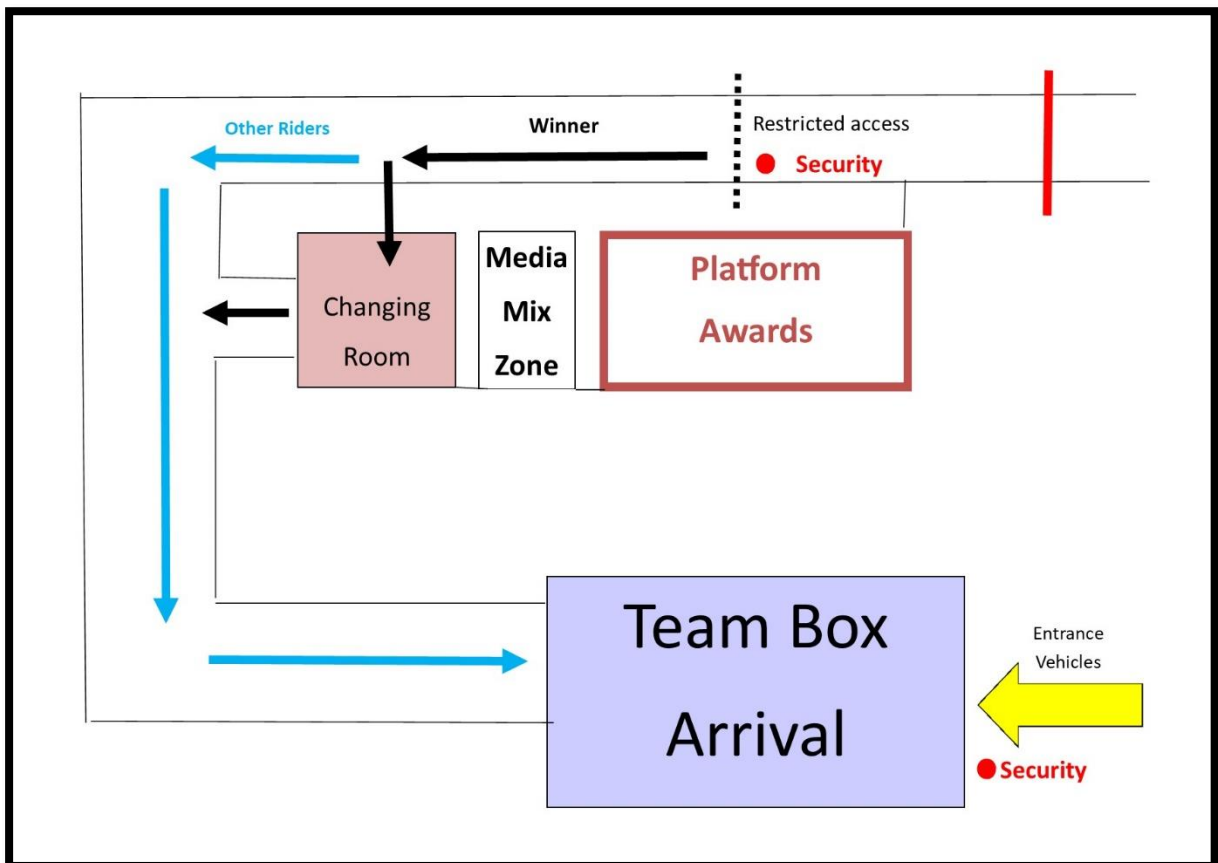
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RACE FINISH

- After the Finish line for 100 metres there will be a delimited space where the public can't enter.
- Only the masseur with the Yellow Pass, Media, and Selected Photographers are allowed to enter in this Area.
- In the changing room (where only Riders, UCI Commissioners and Masseurs are allowed to enter) the distance will be guaranteed.
- Next to the changing room there will be a Media Mix Zone where, respecting the distance, the Riders will be able to do interviews. Only Riders, Organizers with rose band, Media and a press officer are allowed to enter in this zone (green band).
- The return to the Box Team, as for the start, a guided and strictly delimited corridor will be set up, so that no one can enter it except for the Riders.

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PROCEDURES

- Within 72 hours before the race start, the Team must complete the 72 Hours (Confirmation Start) and the Accreditation Form.

The Accreditation Form must contain:

1. Pairing Staff with Vehicle (these staff members will receive a pass card)
 2. List of the people that will receive a pass card (every pass card is personal and cannot be given to someone else)
- Consulting Sport Management in compliance with the regulations on the Anti Covid-19 Protocol issued by the UCI undertakes to solicit and receive from the Organizers all the information necessary to produce all the documentation required by the UCI for the approval of the protocol, Consulting Sport Management is not responsible in the event that a Team does not respect this protocol, also undertakes to deliver the following documents to the UCI Commissioner and other competent bodies and to the Organizing Committee:
 1. a complete list of the Team composition and guests of each single Team.
 2. Complete list of vehicles accompanying the teams.

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SAFETY

Consulting Sport Management will deliver to the managers of each single access (Team Box, Podio signature sheet, Media Mix Zone and Finish Area) the complete list of Teams, personnel and vehicles authorized to access and the type of pass which is allowed access.

These accesses and exit points will be supervised by the Organization's security personnel.

To supervise compliance with the provisions there will be personnel qualified and organized by Consulting Sport Management.

In all areas and for the entire duration of the Exhibition, all current regulations regarding social distancing and use of safety measures issued by the Competent Bodies in the field of Public Health Prevention will be respected, as well as by UCI and FCI Regulations.

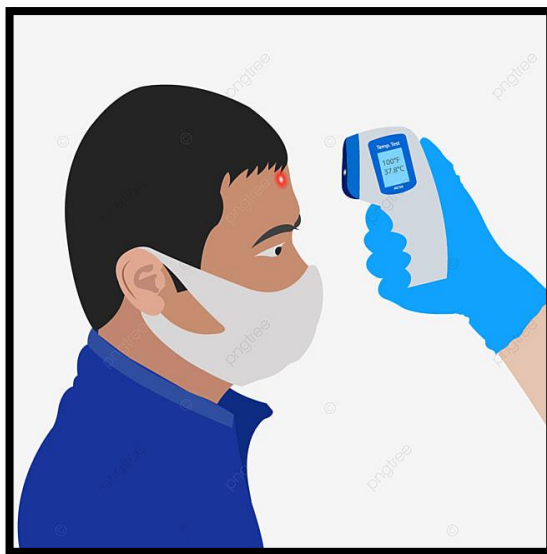


SANITARY PROTOCOL – ORGANIZER - COVID-19 PROCEDURE

All the personnel following the Event are in compliance with the current Covid-19 protocols of the UCI and of the Italian Government, therefore, in compliance with the Complete Vaccination cycle, moreover, before entering the various Bills, personnel will be responsible for the detection body temperature to all personnel following the event.

In the event that symptoms attributable to or suspected of Covid-19 infection are detected, the suspected subject is immediately isolated from the rest of the people following the Event and all the protocols provided by the National Health Service will be adopted, regarding Covid -19 infection.

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Prevention of infections and protection of sanitary bubbles

It is ensured thanks to the countermeasures implemented before the Event, before, during and after the Event.

Pre-event measures

The COVID-19 Coordinator will be in contact with national (or regional) health authorities to ensure the safety of the Event, is responsible for

- Prepare the pandemic severity assessment in the region in advance
- is the advisor for the implementation of the prevention of COVID-19 containment measures
- is the link between the organizer of the event and the health authorities
- prepare, organize, and send the protocol for the management of COVID-19 suspected cases of the Tender, including all phases of patient management up to diagnosis.
- provide the Event Organizer with the criteria for identifying cases of confirmed contact of COVID-19. It must also convey information that could be taken for contact cases (clinical monitoring, isolation, self-isolation, or lack of specific measures, etc.).

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL AREA

Access to the area is allowed only to Healthcare Personnel who will abide by the health protocol provided for this type of activity, to athletes subject to tests accompanied by only one member of their Team. In order to access this area, all interested persons can access it only equipped with PPE model FFP2 as well as being in possession of the requisites required by the UCI.

The definition, application and verification of the rules described in this document are the responsibility of the "COVID-19 Coordinator" (as required by the Anticovid-19 Protocol issued by the UCI

The COVID-19 Coordinator is the one who drafted this protocol and manages the entire management and information process on virus containment measures and acts as a contact point for the various figures involved in the implementation of the Plan.

To supervise compliance with the provisions there will be qualified personnel of the Organizer.

HYGIENIC – SANITARY PRECAUTIONS

Anyone who accesses the areas of the event, for whatever reason, is required to follow the following simple hygienic-sanitary behaviours:

- wash your hands often. Hydroalcoholic solutions for hand washing will be made available in all workspaces
- avoid close contact with people suffering from acute respiratory infections.
- avoid hugs and handshakes
- maintain an interpersonal distance of at least one meter in social contacts
- practice respiratory hygiene (sneezing and / or coughing into a handkerchief avoiding hand contact with respiratory secretions)
- avoid the mixed use of bottles and glasses
- do not touch your eyes, nose, and mouth with your hands
- cover your mouth and nose if you sneeze or cough
- do not take antiviral drugs and antibiotics, unless prescribed by your doctor
- clean the surfaces with chlorine or alcohol-based disinfectants
- It will be necessary in all the social contacts of the working phases, to use respiratory tract protections as an additional measure to the other hygienic-sanitary individual protection measures.

GENERAL MEASURES FOR WORKERS IN CYCLING RACES

The following table describes all the technical and organizational measures taken into consideration for the cycling races, in order to reduce the spread of infection from SARS-CoV-2. The inclusion of these measures is intended to describe how the actions that will be implemented positively affect the reassessment of the risk level.

Adequate Training	Each Employer will ensure adequate training for their staff, according to their own anti-Covid protocols and the guidelines defined by the Organizing Body, in the ways deemed most effective.
Adequate Information	The Organizer will provide adequate information to its workers, supplier companies, media partners, sponsors, sports groups and guests, by sharing its guidelines, anti-Covid protocols, using the most effective tools, even digitally. The public will receive specific information both at the time of booking entry to the controlled access areas (villages, etc.), by means of special signs and by broadcasting audio messages during the sporting event.
Anti-Contagion Security Protocol	All external suppliers and (Catering, Fitters, Sponsors, etc.) must have a specific protocol for their activities consistent with the guidelines defined by the Organizer.
Keep Distance Of 1,5 mt	Social distancing for all users of the areas except for Athletes
Temperature Measurement	Each supplier, Sponsor and Media will measure the temperature of their employees, certifying it to the organizer. Guests, staff and the public will be subjected to temperature control at specific entrance gates.
Sanitizing Gel For Hands	Each access gate will be equipped with a dispenser for hand sanitation
Mask	It is mandatory, in all areas, to wear the FFP2 model mask with the exception of the athletes during the race.
Disposable Gloves	The use of gloves is mandatory for all activities related to the catering service and health care for doping control.
Disposable Gown	The use of a disposable coat is mandatory for all activities related to the health service for doping control
Disposable Apron	The use of an apron is mandatory for all activities related to the catering service.
Keep the list	The organization will keep the attendance lists of all activities for 14 days to be able to trace the presence in the event of an ascertained COVID.
Cleaning and Disinfection	Cleaning will be ensured in the Hospitality, Chemical Services and Headquarters areas.
Air exchange	Closed Environments, such as the Headquarters or food preparation areas, must ensure adequate air circulation.
Ground signage	To ensure social distancing and the adequate positioning of the furnishings in the Hospitality, horizontal signs will be prepared on the floor

Contingent Area	The available areas will be limited to ensure the expected crowding in consideration of the social distancing to be maintained and to define the temperature control points.
Separate entrance and exit	The restricted areas will have separate and supervised entrances and exits in order to avoid the intersection of flows between people
Cleaning Equipment / Work Means	All Suppliers must ensure adequate cleaning of the equipment used and the means of work used
Cleaning and Disinfection	Frequent cleaning will be ensured in the Hospitality, Chemical Services and Headquarters areas.
Identification of Working Groups	All Suppliers, to be distinguishable, must ensure adequate identification (for example, the workers of the same company must have the same uniform)

ARCHIVE NAME

In order to monitor the entire sequence of movements and contacts, all the people accompanying the Event were included in a name archive and divided by services.
 Both all the staff of the Teams and all the staff of the Organization will be equipped with a personal identification pass and coloured bands based on the role held, in order to identify all the persons to authorize to work within the Bills.

RETURN TO FOREIGN TERRITORY - TEST LABORATORY

In case of return to foreign territory where, if necessary, it will be possible to carry out the Molecular PCR Test in the following Laboratories, the cost and booking logistics are borne by the Team.
